


Made-to-measure



L'Aperovino, Bruges

Sommelier Julie Demey and Philip Simoen already worked together on several projects in the past. This time the sommelier wanted to open a restaurant and wine bar which would breathe the same values but would differ from each other in atmosphere. As for this unique location he got a 'carte blanche' for the assignment but on the other hand he had to take into account that the building itself had many restrictions. Not only construction wise, but also some interior features of this classified monument had to be included in the final design of the project, like the iconic Delft tiles.

Philip Simoen is known for creating warm and contemporary interiors and always adding a touch of uniqueness to it. "For L'Aperovino I translated my design language in a material palette of mortex, walnut, tactile textiles and unique light-features which give the space its identity."




An ode to Madonna.

A dream location in the imaginative KMSKA museum of Antwerp, is the house of grand café en fine dining Madonna, a unique place that was named after the world known painting of Jean Fouquet.

Here the multidisciplinary architects office, Verbraeken x Biset collaborated for the second time on an exclusive culinary experience together with hospitality entrepreneur J&M catering.



Fiera, Antwerp

The first collaboration between Jan Jacobs and Verbraeken x Biset was for the hospitality project 'Fiera' where the existing context of the historical building was the blueprint for the design of the restaurant. But for this project 'Madonna' the designers got a white canvas which was provided by KAAN architecten for the museum's renovation. With their concept of the combination of experiences for the audience, they convinced the museum to extend the initial grand café space with a fine dining experience bringing back the 'grandeur' of the past. They were able to widen the audience of a normal museum bar to a proper restaurant with an identity but still as a part of the bigger picture of the museum. This mixed audience and experiences ensures that Madonna is a unique spot for both the art lover as well as the external visitor and works in symbiosis with the vibrant city-life around it.

As for the actual design of the different area's Cathérine Verbraeken explains: "We wanted to translate the luxury, the expertise and the 'class' of the museum to the scale of the restaurant, but in a modern and contemporary way. An ode to detail and craftsmanship today."


The inspiration was found in some of the architectural elements of the building itself, taking the arches and the symmetry for example, as well as referring to the materials as brass, marble and oak woodwork, based on the original doors of the museum. "Within this detailing and craftsmanship de compagnie comes into the picture. We had a high demand on quality and customized finishing. As we've worked together in the past, we knew they could find the right answers for the furniture and fabrics."

As well as providing chairs and tables, de compagnie made the space-defining sculptural bench in the fine dining area. And especially for this project even went that step further in the process to top this design with custom made brass fringe chandeliers. "For us they were the perfect partner to reconcile our aesthetics and the high technical requirements, they went all the way." This top-notch reference is therefore proudly shown by the architects, J&M catering and de compagnie itself.
